

Welcome to On Q Dance Center!

On Q Dance Center offers classes in Tap, Jazz, Lyrical, Hip-Hop, Ballet, Pointe, Preschool & Combo Classes, and a Competitive Company. The emphasis at On Q is Technique based teaching, which teaches the student **how to** dance, not just a dance.

Artistic Director Tammy McCully holds Bachelors in Dance with an emphasis on Choreography. Mrs. Tammy has performed in many major productions and also is an Adjudicated Judge and Master Choreographer for several competition circuits. She has trained and continues to train with some of the best Master Teachers in the United States. Her high energy and drive for quality dance training allows her students to reach new heights in individual accomplishments and self confidence that will stay with them throughout life.

Classes

It's On Q's philosophy that all students receive the same professional technique training whether the student is taking dance as a casual experience, a competitive experience, or is striving to be a professional someday. On Q offers classes for students 18 months old through the young adult. All students will be placed in a class with age as a guideline and technical skill level as the primary factor. The number of students in each class will be limited at the Director's discretion based on the type of class, age, and skill level. Class availability is dependent on the number of sign ups and available time slots for each class.

Recitals & Parades

On Q Dance Center will give students the opportunity to show their skills in dance at both a winter and spring show. All students are invited to perform in the shows. In addition to the winter and spring shows, Company members will be given the chance to compete in 2 – 4 competitions throughout the year and hold their own Showcase. Dancers will have the chance to perform & participate in various summer, winter, and spring parades.

The monthly tuition is based on the number of hours per week a student is enrolled in classes and is inclusive of tuition only. Tuition for Technique and Company classes is broken down into ten (10) low monthly payments (Sept - June). We offer a 10% sibling discount on Technique Class Tuition. ALL siblings receive the 10% discount. Monthly Tuition is due the first day of class each month. There will be a \$10.00 late fee if we received tuition after the 15th of the month.

Our Annual Non-Refundable Registration Fee is \$20.00 per family regardless of how many siblings.

Our 2009 -2010 season runs late August to mid June.

Tuition Continued

Company Tuition is \$25.00 per month (flat rate) and is inclusive to tuition only. All Company members are required to take Ballet in addition to the related weekly Technique Class. Company members are also required to take summer classes. Auditions are held yearly for placement purposes. Our 10% sibling discount does not include Company Tuition

Dress Code

For all classes unless otherwise stated – any color leotard, Jazz pants, or dance shorts – black, tan, pink or white tights may be worn. All hair must be worn in a bun or slicked pony tail. No pony tails in Ballet or Pointe.

Preschool Classes – Any color leotard & tights, black tap shoes, pink ballet slippers.

Combo Classes - Any color leotard & tights, black tap shoes, pink ballet slippers, black jazz shoes.

Ballet - Any solid color leotard. Pink or white tights. Ballet skirts & leg warmers are allowed. Ballet slippers in canvass or leather.

Pointe - Any style black leotard. Pink or white tights. Ballet skirts & leg warmers are allowed. Pointe shoes any brand.

Tap - Black tap shoes – Capezio or Leo preferred.

Jazz – Black or tan slip on no ties.

Lyrical – Jazz shoe or Ballet slipper.

Hip-Hop – Appropriate dance attire. No street shoes, no jeans, no sweatshirts.

Our Policy

We have an open door policy because direct communication is the best way to alleviate any misunderstandings. If you or our client fail to come directly to us to discuss any concerns you may have in regards to your child and On Q dance Center, this open door policy will not work. Please approach us!

No dancer will be permitted in class unless we have a completed registration form & registration fee for the current season.

ACCOUNT PAYMENTS WILL BE APPLIED TO OUTSTANDING BALANCES IN THIS ORDER:

1. Tuition
2. Costumes
3. Competition Fees
4. On Q Gear, Recital Tickets, etc.

Costumes not paid for by On Q's due date will not be ordered. Competition Fees not paid for by On Q's due date will result in your child not being entered in the competition. Once ordered, costumes fees are nonrefundable. Once sent in, competition fees are nonrefundable. NO POST DATED CHECKS.

Monthly Tuition is due at the **first class** each month. After the 15th of the month, tuition is considered late and a \$10.00 late fee will be added to delinquent accounts on the 16th of each month. If payment of tuition is not up to date by the 21st of the current month, your child will not be allowed to attend class until your unpaid tuition has been paid in full. All tuition charged to your account prior to any recital / show must be paid in full as a delinquent account will cause a child not to perform in the recital / show. All N.S.F. check charges will be passed on to you. One N.S.F. Incident requires all future payments (tuition, costumes, etc.) for the current year to be paid in cash. There are no credits or refunds for missed classes or dropouts. Absences may be made up within 30 days of a missed class but may not be applied towards future tuition. Classes cancelled due to inclement weather or other non controllable circumstances will not be made up. We reserve the right to cancel classes and reschedule them if needed.

Students are expected to follow our dress code for all classes.

A class with less than six students may be cancelled, combined with another class or students switched to another similar class.

Parents are responsible for reading all newsletters & studio information via our website or studio bulletin board. **Most of this info is emailed to you if we have a valid email address for you.**

Please try to be on time for the start of class. Late entry into the class is not only disturbing to the class, but is also unfair to the student that misses part of the warm-up. If you drop off, please come into the building to pick up your child if they are 11 years old or younger. Please be considerate of other children in your child's class and call us if your child is not going to make it to class due to illness, etc. Please pick up your children at the end of your child's class(es) as we cannot supervise them and will not be responsible for them.

Student viewing week is generally the first full week of each month and may be cancelled or moved to a different week at the discretion of the Artistic Director due to holidays or upcoming shows. Student viewing is available through a monitor in the lobby so parents/relatives may enjoy viewing and the students get the full uninterrupted benefit of the class.

We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items on or off premises.

During inclement weather we may still remain open despite any and all area school closings. Please check local TV channel 13 for any closings.

Please, do not enter the class room if the door is closed. Please wait for the class before you to finish and you have been asked to enter.

Please, no eating, drinking or gum chewing in the dance room. Dancers are allowed to bring their own water bottle. No eating or drinking of any kind in the lobby.
